Subject- Conferring the Kalpana Chawla Young Lady Researcher Award.

Whereas, the Management Council in its meeting held on 23.9.2003 vide item No. 430 has resolved to institute Kalpana Chawla Young Lady Researcher Award in Memory of Late Kalpana Chawla , 2005

And

Whereas , The Management Council Has framed Rule No. 9 of 2005 For conferring the kalpana Chawla Young Lady Researcher Award ;

And

Whereas, Scrutiny Committee, constituted under the rule 8 of rule No. 9 of 2005, in its meeting held on 2/11/2006; has recommended that it is expedient to make some important amendments in Rule No. 9 of 2005;

And

Whereas, The Power to amend Rule No. 9 of 2005 are vested in the Management Council of the university

And

Whereas, Preparing The Draft (Amendment) Rule for Amending Rule No. 9 of 2005 and getting it approved by the Management Council will take some time,

And

Whereas, notification and issuing an advertisement for The award is to be given on or before 10th November ,2006.

Now Therefore, I, Dr, Kamal Singh , vice – chancellor of Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University , Amravati In exercise of powers conferred upon me under sub section (8) of Section 14 of Maharashtra University Act, 1994 , Herby Direct as under –

- 1) This Direction shall be called ' Conferring the Kalpana Chawla young Lady Researcher Award Direction , 2006
- 2) This direction Shall Come into Force from The date of its Issuance .

3) Objective ;

The Kalpana Chawla Young Lady Researcher Award is Instituted With an Objective to Encourage and Inspire the Young lady researchers to Undertake research of an unraveled Nature and achieve heights of excellence in research in the field of Science , Engineering And Technology Within The ambit Of Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University .

4) Eligibility :

- a) The Award Shall be given Every year to a Young Lady Researcher Who Is Below the age of 35 years as on 30th November of The Concerned Year.

And

- b) Who has done outstanding research work which is acclaimed and recognized as such by the experts in the concerned discipline.

And

- c) Ph.D. Degree of The Universities of vidhrabha region .

And

- d) Who has Published outstanding research papers in the concerned research Journals of repute and Whose Published Work is acclaimed as the original and Outstanding Piece of research in the Concerned discipline .

OR

After obtaining a ph. D. degree , the candidate must have demonstrated her capacity to Pursue independent research Work by Way of Single author papers (not from her Ph.D.and /or M.sc. thesis) in the Journals of repute and / or who must have at least one ongoing research project sanctioned by the scientific bodies / agencies such as DST, CSIR, ICAR, DBT,DAE, UGC, etc. an not by any political agencies such as Rajiv Gandhi Pratishtan , Deendayal Upadhyay trust , etc,

5) Nature Of Award

The Award Shall be in the form of cash prize of Rs, 10,000/- and a citation to that effect.

- 6) The University shall invite the applications for the consideration of this award from the deserving researcher by issuing an advertisement and press notification to that effect for the knowledge of the aspirants of this award, such notification shall be issued by the University on or before the 10th of November every year.
- 7) The aspirants Of this Award shall apply to the University in The prescribed format as enclosed in **Annexure-I** In 10 copies on or before the 30th November of that year and shall Submit the authenticated copies of the following documents ;

- 1) Date Of Birth Certificate From the Competent authority.
 - 2) Certificate of Domicile / Residence.
 - 3) Certificate From the present employer. (if In Service)
 - 4) The attested copies of research papers published in the recognized journals along with the name, volume and page number of the recognized journal.
 - 5) The attested copies of Mark list, degree certificate.
 - 6) The Copy of Outstanding research Work Which is acclaimed and recognized as such by the Experts in the concerned discipline.
 - 7) The Copies of letter from UGC, AICTE, DST, CSIR or any other equivalent bodies Sanctioning Major or Minor Research Project.
 - 8) The Copies of the Award, If Any, received.
- The late application from shall not be taken into consideration under any circumstances whatsoever.
- 9) All such application received shall be placed before the scrutiny Committee of the University

The Composition of The scrutiny Committee shall be as under;

- 9) The Scrutiny Committee shall Closely Scrutinize the applications of the Candidate for short listing them. The two short listed candidates we have to deliver a 60-90 minutes talk on their Research work, depending upon the performance, the awarded will be selected.
- 10) If the scrutiny committee feels that no applicant qualifies for the receipt of this award the committee may recommend the suspension of the award in that year stating reasons for it I Writing.
- 11) The decision of the scrutiny committee shall be final and appeal shall lie anywhere on its decision.
- 12) This Award shall be announced on the 30th March of Every year and the award shall be ceremonially awarded to the recipient on 1st day of the month of May.
- 13) In The event of any Controversy regarding the declaration of the award the matter shall be determined by The Management Council its shall be final.
- 14) The Operation and implementation of the Rule No. 9/2005 shall be kept in abeyance till the Draft (Amendment) Rule amending Rule No. 9/2005 is approved by the Management Council.
